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FOOD

- LARGE SUPERMARKETS ARE USUALLY THE CHEAPEST PLACES TO BUY YOUR FOOD.
- IT COSTS LESS TO COOK YOUR OWN MEALS THAN BUYING READY COOKED MEALS.
- IF YOU ARE SHARING WITH OTHERS IT IS CHEAPER TO BUY FOOD IN BULK.

MORE HANDY TIPS

- GET A FREE HAIRCUT BY BEING A MODEL AT A LOCAL HAIRDRESSERS OR COLLEGE.
- TRY THE LIBRARY FOR INTERNET ACCESS, BOOKS, DVDs, AND CDs.
